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NEW RECOMMENDATIONS

Stocks added to our Recommended List.

To heck with the damp rag a lingering U.S. government shutdown may throw on near-term economic growth. We're (finally) buying into a stock that we really should have bought during the August market weakness—after missing the boat previously with a strongly bullish insider signal way back in March.

Shares of Park City Group (PCYG) have recovered better than most since the late-summer lull—and that was before the firm released growth-affirming year-end results on September 23. With PCYG beginning another uptrend, we're buying into this stock's momentum along with insiders as PCYG gives up a tad of upside along with most stocks during this latest bout of Beltway dysfunction

Park City Group sells software and services that give food retailers visibility to their consumer goods supply chain. The company's mantra is "sell more, stock less, see everything". Park city switched from a license to a subscription model over a year ago, which makes it a Software-as-a-Service ("SaaS") provider in current lingo. The success of its wares is owed to them increasing customers' sales and profitability while allowing lower inventory levels and ensuring regulatory compliance for both retailers and their suppliers.

Park City remains a microcap with only \$150 million in market cap, even after its stock tripled in price in 2013. Its tiny size was the reason we did not consider PCYG for our Recommended List when insiders sent a clearly bullish signal back on March 15.

Back in March, the company's nine directors all bought into a private placement for a total \$1.7 million investment. Seven of the buyers had 100% "Hit Rates" on their past purchases, with mean returns of 50% to 120% over the varying time frames of their trades. All the directors also increased their holdings very significantly with their private purchases. (See a snapshot of PCYG's insider profile on Page 3, as it appears in our Subscription Data Module with our new Insider Statistics and Company Ratings.)

Our insider research shows that there is no reason to look at purchases undertaken via private placements any differently than those in the open market—as long as the company is getting the proceeds. It's still real money and

real increases in insiders' economic interest occurring. We don't even mind when insider buyers get a slightly better price to buy a volume of shares that couldn't be moved otherwise. That was the case with the March private placement, which was part of an accretive company funding used to redeem dividend-demanding preferred shares.

Insiders confirmed their bullishness with more purchases in May and July as PCYG was in the midst of trading strongly higher. More recently, three directors who were smart buyers in the past, increased their holdings significantly again, by exercising warrants at the end of August—and holding onto all of them.

With costs largely fixed, and a growing base business with small-to-medium food retailers, Park City looks set to become profitable any quarter now. For its fiscal 2013 (ended June 30), the company increased its sales a respectable 12% year-over-year, to \$11.3 million, while actually decreasing operating expenses a modicum, to \$10.9 million. That moved the company from a loss to a profit on a net income basis in fiscal 2013—before hefty preferred dividends ate into profits.

Still, Park City's loss per share lessened from negative 14 cents in 2012, to just negative 5 cents last year. With revenues expected to increase solidly, and much of those preferred dividends now retired, bottom-line profits in fiscal 2014 appear unavoidable from its established small-to-medium customer focus.

But it is the prospect of Park City landing larger retail clients (that are presently testing its services) that could provide much more exciting growth. The four large retailers that are currently testing Park City's services have a combined 25k stores. This includes a test with "one of the world's largest retailers" who is "well known for its technological expertise," according to Park City Chairman & CEO, Randall K. Fields. He further asserts that the test is "moving along very well".

Park City has also positioned itself to benefit when regulations from the 2011 Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) are finally promulgated, via its investment and collaboration in ReposiTrak. More than just a system for tracing where a single food item originates, Repos-

iTrak is a cross functional platform that can be used by the hundreds of companies that already trace the original cow behind any given steak.

Seeing the promise of the food safety business in the U.S. and abroad, Park City recently provided financing to the collaboration that gives it an option to up its ReposiTrak stake from 49%, to 79%.

With an improved balance sheet, solid base business, and opportunities for larger growth opportunities, Park City's management expects to use its growing cash flow to pay down debt and buy back shares.

Like most microcap firms, PCYG is under the radar of Wall Street—and most investors as well. We found it interesting that not one analyst from any sized sell-

side firm asked a question during Park City's Q4 teleconference—if they were on the call at all. Instead, it was a few money managers that did the prodding.

In answer to questions about the potential upside to Park City's business, CEO Fields relayed that “in 3 to 5 years, we could be doing \$50 million in revenues, and it would still be a small percentage of markets that we're serving”.

We find this assertion feasible, making it not outrageous to buy into PCYG now—even though it looks technically overextended after its stellar run over the past year. Limit orders only for this microcap, however.

COMPANY UPDATES

Updated research on past recommendations.

Our Recommended List out performed its Russell 2000 and S&P 500 benchmarks by a wide margin yet again last week (see Page 2 for the stats).

Over a third of the positions on our List gained more than the 2.1% average of our portfolio during a week of flat-to-down performance for the overall market. This made the stocks we own that also merely traded flat-to-down a drag on our performance—making them candidates for culling as we look to concentrate our bets more.

And we are culling this week. We are doing so to make room for more of the stocks that insiders have been more active in recently—when we feel the time is right to buy into them. Our addition of Park City Group (PCYG) late last week is only the first of several we expect to swap out for the older names we are selling this issue. But with the latest bout of Beltway dysfunction still a risk, we are being quicker to cull than replace.

Stocks we are Selling in today's issue include:

**Six Flags (SIX);
Fuel Systems (FSYS);
Support.com (SPRT);
Express Scripts (ESRX), and;
LivePerson (LPSN).**

SIX, FSYS, and SPRT have all been successful positions. SIX generated a total return of 26.3% during our 48-week holding period. FSYS returned 41% over 47 weeks, and SPRT was up 26% in 26 weeks.

While insiders have helped us find a decent number of home runs over the past decade plus of this particular service, these solid hits are the sorts of returns and holding periods that are the bread-and-butter of our Recommended List's consistent out performance.

SIX and FSYS are weeks away from their one-year anniversaries, and could be held longer if tax considerations are critical. We are not selling any of the above five positions this issue because

we expect imminent declines in them. Their recent under performance relative to our other Recommended List positions, however, has been noticeable for weeks now. So has the advent of insider selling in all the names we are culling.

ESRX and LPSN are up and down a minor 6.6% and minus 3.4%, respectively, over their 20-23 week holding periods. These two positions have been disappointingly too much like dead money. And with insider selling more obvious in both names at this time, we see little reason to expect stock-moving September quarter results.

In the end, it is the combination of relative technical weakness plus deteriorating insider profiles that makes us conclude it is time to move on from these five names. As we await another round of quarterly earnings and forward outlooks, we have found it more profitable to be invested in names that insider have committed their own cash to more recently—especially those that also already have fundamental and/or price momentum.

INSIDE THE MARKET

Our Interpretation of Insiders' Top-Down Sentiment.

The 4-week average of our insider buy/sell ratios (aka, our Insider-Based Market Indicator) fell again last week, from negative 130%, to negative 147%. That is now well below the negative 80% threshold that over the longer-term has tended to mark market tops during "normal" market conditions. It's also below the level where it last reversed higher at the end of July, in concert with the late summer market pull back.



While present political and geo-political concerns are similar to those the market has already ingested in recent years, the expectation for the long running too-loose-for-our-own-good monetary policy to (finally) be tapered in the very near future is

that new factor to consider along with the Beltway dysfunction. Taking it all in, we doubt our Indicator can again fall significantly (to, say, -200%) in concert with a continued market rally.

To be sure, U.S. equities still look attractive to us versus other asset classes globally. But it's tough to pound the table on their behalf as hard as we have for most of this year. More specifically, with the volume of insider filings waning into the quarter end, we have fewer new bullish company specific insider signals to act on. (See Page 5).

So giving a nod to the near-term uncertainty, we finally raised cash again last week—but only to 5%.
